The Paner Access Medule (FAM) enables you, as a parent, to access the latest about your child's progress. After logging in to the after you will be able to.

Unique usernames and passwords have been sent home to each family which will give you access to PAM and allow you to view information related to your child's progress. <u>UPDATE: Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability</u> (NCCD)



Over the last few weeks, you will have read in this Newsletter about the National Consistent Collection Of Data (NCCD). NCCD being a collection that counts:

- 1. the number of students receiving an adjustment or 'help' due to disability
- 2. the levels of adjustment they are receiving to access education on the same basis as other Students and we provide this information to education authorities

What Are The Benefits Of The NCCD For Students?

The information collected by the NCCD helps teachers, principals, education authorities and governments to better support students with disability at school.

The NCCD encourages schools to review their learning and support systems and processes. This helps schools to continually improve education outcomes for all students.

What Must Schools Do For Students With Disability?

All students have the right to a quality learning experience at school.

Students with disability must be able to take part in education without discrimination and on the same basis as other students. To ensure this, schools must make reasonable adjustments if needed for students with disability. Educators, students, parents, carers and others (eg health professionals) must work together to ensure that students with disability can take part in education.

The **Disability Discrimination Act 1992** and the **Disability Standards for Education 2005** describe schools' responsibilities.

Who is Included in The NCCD?

The definition of disability for the NCCD is based on the broad definition under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992.

REMINDER: Beginning of the Day

A significant number of our children are arriving late to school and many long after the 8:55am start time. This is a friendly reminder that the school expectation is that parents drop their children at school from 8:30am, with school starting promptly in the classroom at 8:55am. Children arriving late impacts on the children's organisation and ability to settle quickly into the classroom routine. This also affects the classroom and their learning.

Children arriving after 8:55am will also be marked on the attendance register as late.

School Health and Safety Measures return for children

The return to onsite school attendance is based on the advice of the Victorian Chief Health Officer. We have considered a variety of strategies to support physical distancing, particularly among adults, and good hygiene practices to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission within the practical limitations of our school environment.

Any child who is unwell must not attend school.

Beginning of the Day Drop Off

At no stage are parents able to enter any classroom. Red Tape and Distance markers will be outside each classroom door to remind all adults.

From Wednesday 27th May, parents will be required to drop their children off in the undercover area and then exit the school in a prompt manner. Staff will be present in the undercover area from 8:30am to assist children with walking to their classrooms if required.

End of the Day Dismissal

To minimise congestion within and outside of the school and following the advice of the Victorian Chief Health Officer a staggered approach for collection of children will be implemented from Tuesday 26th May, 2020.

To minimise congestion, especially among adults, we ask families to adhere to this timetable and to be vigilant when promptly entering and exiting the building. Teachers will not be available to engage in discussion with parents at drop off or dismissal time and we ask parents to refrain from stopping and engaging in conversation with children and adults while onsite.

The following addition measures will be implemented from Tuesday 26th May 2020:

- Entry and exit points to the school will be open, with additional staff allocated to ensure children are safely supervised
- Parents are not to enter classrooms at any stage and are to adhere to social distancing guidelines when waiting to collect their child at the classroom door
- Asking parents to avoid or minimise time spent in or around the school grounds
- Frequent announcements, messages, signage and red gaffer tape around school to remind staff, children and families of the need for changed behaviours

Seasons for Growth Program

Our Seasons for Growth program will begin early Term 3. Seasons for Growth is an innovative, evidence-based change, loss and grief education program that draws on the metaphor of the seasons to understand the experience of grief. It builds the knowledge and skills necessary to strengthen social and emotional wellbeing following significant loss by:

- Exploring the impact of change and loss
- Learning about effective ways to respond and adapt

Participants learn that they are not alone in their experience of change, loss and grief, and are able to build their communication, decision making and problem solving skills within the context of a safe and supportive peer group learning environment.

All Seasons for Growth programs are grounded in sound, person-centred educational principles.
